In particular, he was the principal drafter of the following statewide measures: Propositions 10 (State and County Early Childhood Development Programs; 1998), 50 (Water Quality, Supply and Safe Drinking Water Projects, Coastal Wetlands Purchase and Protection; 2002), and 10 (Alternative Fuel Vehicles and Renewable Energy; 2008).
